**BONAIRE ANNOUNCES CONTINENTAL AIRLINES TO LAUNCH NON-STOP SERVICE BETWEEN
HOUSTON AND BONAIRE**
- Weekly Flight to Begin December 16, 2005 -

Kralendijk, Bonaire – (June 27, 2005) – Less than one month following the commencement of negotiations, an agreement between Continental Airlines and the island of Bonaire was signed on June 23rd. Beginning December 16, 2005 Continental Airlines will launch a weekly non-stop round-trip flight from its Houston hub to/from Bonaire.

Flight #1898 will depart Houston on Fridays at 11:30 p.m., arriving in Bonaire on Saturdays at 6:15 a.m. The return flight, #1899, will depart Bonaire on Saturdays at 8:00 a.m., arriving in Houston at 10:50 a.m. Continental Airlines will use a Boeing 737 airplane with 124 seats including 12 first class seats.

Continental Airlines is the world's sixth largest airline. Continental, together with Continental Express and Continental Connection has more than 3,000 daily departures throughout the Americas, Europe and Asia, serving 150 domestic and 130 international destinations, more than any other carrier in the world.
